John 15: 12 – 17

12 My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. **13** Greater love has no one than this: that he lay down his life for his friends. **14** You are my friends if you do what I command.

15 I no longer call you servants, because a servant does not know his master's business. Instead, I have called you friends, for everything that I learned from my Father I have made known to you. **16** You did not choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit—fruit that will last. Then the Father will give you whatever you ask in my name. **17** This is my command: Love each other.
